

Aberdeen & Northern Marts sold 796 bales of fodder on Friday 21st March 2025

“With fewer bales of straw forward, the ring witnessed a 43% clearance rate for straw. An increased demand for hay seen 42% of the catalogue entries sold. Silage remains challenging to sell with only 12% sold to limited buyers. With the sun shining only 10% of the turnips were sold.”

Spring Barley Straw: Sold to £11 per bale for inside round bales and averaged £9.50 for 398 bales sold.

Hay Bales: Sold to £19 per bale and averaged £11.50 for 298 bales sold.

Silage: Sold to £19 per bale for 100 bales sold.

Lifted Turnips: Sold to £35 per tonne.
