Sold 98 Prime Cattle.

Under 30 Month – Prime Bullocks (26) averaged 346.2p (p) and sold to 393p per kg for a 620kg Limousin Cross from Whiteside, Tullynessle and £2934.80 gross for a 920kg Charolais Cross from Newton of Clunie, Turriff.

Prime Heifers (51) averaged 373.9p (p) and sold to 429p per kg for a 595kg Limousin from Cairnhill, Huntly and £2861.45 gross for a 755kg Limousin Cross from Cuttyhill Croft, Rora.

Young Bulls (21) averaged 357.8p (p) and sold to 375p per kg for a 725kg Charolais Cross from Shank of Glenbarry, Knock and £2982 gross for an 840kg Charolais Cross from Newmills of Boyne, Cornhill.

“An excellent entry of 98 prime saw a more commercial show forward, leading to a top for today of £2934.80 for a Charolais Cross bullock from Mr Moggach, Newton of Clunie. With heifers meeting excellent demand saw a 595kg Limousin achieving 429p per kilo. With a steady trade throughout was maintained by a large ringside of buyers.”
