Bullocks (255) averaged 418.5p (+120.7ppk on the year) and sold to 497.7p per kg for a Pair of 426kg Limousin Cross from Cornhill, Cullerlie and £2690 gross for a 720kg Simmental Cross from Moa, Stenness.

Aberdeen-Angus Bullocks (20) averaged 409.3p (+123.6ppk on the year) and sold to 427.4p per kg for a Pen of Four 496kgs from Windywalls, Westray and £2480 gross for a Pen of Five 620kgs from Appieteen, Sandwick.

Heifers (225) averaged 419.5p (+117.9ppk on the year) and sold to 512.8p per kg for a 468kg Simmental Cross from Newton of Coldwells, Auchnagatt and £2600 gross for a 510kg Limousin Cross from Campdalmore, Tomintoul.

Autumn Born Bullocks (356) averaged 466.1p (+141ppk on the year) and sold to 560.2p per kg for a 382kg Limousin Cross from Clinterty, New Aberdour and £2450 gross for a Pair of 584kg Charolais Cross from Wellheads, Huntly.

Autumn Born Heifers (286) averaged 443.6p (+142ppk on the year) and sold to 511.7p per kg for a 426kg Charolais Cross and £2500 gross for a 502kg Charolais Cross both from Wellheads, Huntly.

The Annual Show & Sale of Autumn born calves kindly sponsored by Grays Feed Services, the ringside witnessed a fantastic show of well bred & presented calves. The judging was ably carried out by Mr Kevin Proctor, Mains of Tollo and his overall champion was found in a 472kg Limousin Heifer which also was the champion heifer from the Roberston Family, Fodderletter selling at £2500 to Mr Jack Stuart. Champion Bullock was awarded to the Buchan Family, Clinterty for a Limousin Cross scaling 568kgs selling for £2440 to Mr Ian Sim.

The £100 awarded by the British Charolais Cattle society for the 1st Prize pen of four or pair of Charolais sired calves was awarded to the first prize pen of four Bullocks from the Gordon family, Wellheads weighing 494kgs selling at £2380. Second prize from the society and receiving the £50 was the first Prize pair of heifers from Messers Stuart, Belnoe achieving £2400 at 538kgs.”
