## SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF SALE FOR

## FEMALE TEXEL SHEEP

- 1. All sheep will be sold subject to the Conditions of Sale of the British Texel Sheep Society and to the Auctioneer's General Conditions of Sale which are available at the Auctioneers' Office.
- 2. Commissions will be charged at the rate of 4.5%. In addition there will be a charge of 0.5% on all sales paid to NOSTC.
- 3. No dressing, clipping or the use of bloom dips on the fleeces of the sheep will be permitted. An inspection and committee will have the authority to disqualify any sheep misrepresenting Breed Society Rules. BTSS reserve the right to take wool or draw blood samples for testing.
- 4. Sheep will only be accepted into the market and PENNED for sale if they are accompanied by a Ministry of Agriculture Certificate of Official MV Status which has been correctly completed
- 5. Sheep can be NSP / Private Genotyped.
- 6. All sheep must be PENNED by 1.00 pm on Monday 24<sup>th</sup> November 2025, no entries will be accepted after this time.
- 7. After PENNING all sheep must remain in the premises until time of sale.
- 8. All sheep will be identified with numbered plastic tags hung at the neck.
- 9. All sheep must be accompanied by a certificate of dipping if it is deemed necessary at the time.
- 10. All consigners must be paid up members of the **North of Scotland Texel Club**, as well as members of the British Texel Sheep Society. New members are limited to entries in the first two years (see condition 16).
- 11. Entry Fees: £10 per head including VAT.
- 12. Pedigree Certificates must accompany entries (No photo-copies)
- 13. Substitutes are limited **to one in every five** sheep entered. They must be marked with a RED DOT on the back. In addition all their particulars should be displayed on the PEN to allow clear identification to prospective buyers.
- 14. All sheep must be correct in mouth to be forward for sale.
- 15. All consignors are limited to a maximum of 10 entries per class (apart from new consignors see condition 16)
- 16. New consignors (limited to 3 per class for the first 2 years) and must also be paid up members of the North of Scotland Texel Club for at least 3 months

## Minimum acceptable prices:

Ewes - 350gns; Gimmers 350gns; Ewe Lambs - 200gns.
