NOTICE TO VENDORS AND PURCHASERS

It is the responsibility of each Vendor to ensure that Vendor declarations in relation to the Bovine Viral Diarrhoea ("BVD") status of all animals provided to Auctioneers are accurate declarations as at the date of sale.

However, Purchasers should be aware that an accurate Vendor declaration cannot absolutely guarantee that any animal or progeny from any animal is free from BVD or is not a persistently infected ("PI") animal.

Auctioneers cannot accept any responsibility for the accuracy or reliability of any Vendor declarations and no warranties or guarantees whatsoever are given by the Auctioneers.

| BVD Category 1 BVD Accredited / Individually Tested Negative | Cattle are not pregnant and are either from an Accredited BVD-Free Herd through a CheCS cattle health scheme or Individually tested BVD virus free | Very low risk |
| BVD Category 2 BVD Herd Screened Negative | From a herd with a 'negative' BVD herd status through a mandatory annual screening or certified virus free and vaccinated. | Low risk |
| BVD Category 3 BVD Status Unknown | All cattle not in either of the categories above (including from 'not-negative' herds) | Risk unknown |

Please Note, pregnant animals are always a greater risk and therefore cannot be assigned as Category 1, very low risk.

Pregnant animals, which would otherwise be category one must be assigned as Category 2 (low risk).

ANM GROUP HEALTH AND SAFETY RULES

NOTICE TO ALL VISITORS AND TRADERS.

All visitors and traders on site will be responsible for ensuring that they and their employees or sub-contractors engaged by them comply with all legal requirements, including the Health and Safety at Work etc., Act 1974, The Management of Health and Safety at Work Regulations, The Provision and Use of Work Equipment Regulations, etc.

All visitors and traders will be responsible for ensuring that their operations in no way affect the integrity of the company or its fire, safety or security arrangements and in no way compromise the health, safety and welfare of other visitors to and or employees of ANM Group.

After reversing into the loading banks before exiting their vehicle to unload/load livestock at ANM Group Livestock Marts, Hauliers, Farmers, Exhibitors must follow the "Safe Stop Procedure" -

- 1) Engage handbrake
- 2) Controls in neutral
- 3) Switch off engine
- 4) Remove key

Refer to the ANM Transport Management Plan posted in the Mart Office within Quoybrae Livestock Centre.

When loading or unloading livestock hauliers, farmers and exhibitors will be responsible for unloading/loading of their livestock in/out of their float/trailer. **ANM Group Livestock Handlers will not be permitted to enter the loading bank pens until the livestock are placed in the pen and gates closed the livestock is secure in the loading bank pen.**

Vendors must inform ANM Group of any livestock due to attend the market whose temperament, behaviour or condition may call for additional precautions for its safe handling.

In the case of bulls, during the period when show and sale is open to visitors, bulls in pens must not be left unattended.

If the vendor is temporarily absent, arrangements should be made with another vendor, steward or member of ANM Group staff to oversee the bull until the handler returns.

Visitors and Traders enter the Livestock areas at their own risk, this area has been assessed as a high-risk area where inexperienced persons have a higher risk of harm. Please cooperate with the ANM Group Livestock team by leaving the area when the Livestock Sale commences.

Traders should ensure that livestock handlers/exhibitors are fit, experienced in livestock handling and familiar with the livestock in their charge.

Children must not be permitted in any area where they may be at risk from livestock or machinery.

Handling of Livestock at shows and sales: ANM Group recommend that an adult person should accompany any junior person during the showing/sale of livestock in the ring and reserves the right to intervene at any point if, in the company's opinion, the person showing the livestock is at risk in undertaking the activity.

All portable electrical equipment supplied and /or used by visitors and traders must be safe and fit for purpose and should have a valid portable appliance test certificate (hair dryers and other equipment).

Passageways must be kept clear at all times during the auction sale. **PLEASE DO NOT STAND IN THE SALE RING ENTRANCE AND EXIT PASSAGES.**

The auction ring man escapes and refuges must be kept clear at all times.
